### *Examination of Main Deck.*

The s.s. No 1. was held at Hull in September last and the notation assigned subject to the deck, which was worn then, being renewed within 9 months from that date.

The Hull Surveyors now report that they have examined the deck in question, it is sheathed all over, and in their opinion safe for present use.

The Owner proposes to defer the renewal of the deck for 6 months, which the Surveyors consider to be satisfactory.

It is submitted:— the Owners proposal to renew the deck in 6 months time, merits the favourable consideration of the Committee, and the vessel appears worthy to remain classed 90 A.1. Subject to this being done within that time.
