Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 12th instant regarding the internal survey held this time for Freeboard Assignment on the Barge "LIZZIE & ANNIE", I herewith beg to forward an amended report as per your instructions.

With regard to the discrepancy between the sheers reported in the Hull report No. 16102, July 1904, and Hull Report No. 26898 I beg to say that I had report No. 16102 before me and in view of the difference of the measurements I checked my measurements again in dry dock and found same correct. On receipt of your letter of the 12th instant I again checked the measurements when vessel was afloat and found no difference.

The only correction I find necessary is that the Round of Beam should be $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches in lieu of 5 inches as stated on my report.


