Freeboard - Trading Limits.

With reference to your letter dated the 13th. August, 1932, addressed to Mr. W. SCOTT, and asking for information as to the limits of the above named vessel's service etc. etc., we do not propose to send the vessel beyond the Rivers TYNE and THAMES.

It is very seldom indeed that the "LIZZIE & ANNIE" proceeds any further Northward and Southward than she does whilst engaged in her present service, but we should like the necessary sanction so that we may - if occasions should arise - send her to other places within the limits stated above.

If the desired limits be such that you cannot endorse the relative certificate accordingly unless you previously alter the freeboard now assigned, we should be obliged if you would again kindly communicate with us before you do anything further concerning the matter.
