Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 1st instant with reference to the Motor Vessel "LIZZIE AND ANNIE", and note that the Owner of this vessel has decided to dispense with the sails.

I therefore have to inform you that provided the vessel be reclassified, the sails and their accompanying spars and gear be removed as proposed so as to convert the vessel from a sailing to a motor vessel, and the hatchways and casings be found or made efficient, a Summer freeboard of 1'-0" from statutory deck line 1 inch above wood upper deck at side could be approved.

I shall be glad if you will forward full particulars required on the back of an llb form for Official assignment together with a sketch shewing the masts and spars (if any) left in the vessel.
