The Main & Donkey Boilers examined & put into good order, a few shot stays renewed.

The Main & Donkey Safety Valves examined & tested under steam.

The Main & Donkey ^{bulge} have been fitted to burn oil fuel, as per attached sketch. An evaporator has also been supplied to make good the steam used for the burners, a small pump has been fitted to pump the fuel out of the intended oil tanks No 2 & 3.The steam out to Callao with ordinary coal, on her arrival at that port the communication between the No 2 & 3 tanks & the ordinary ballast pump will be cut off by blank flanges, the flanges are on board & when fitted, notice will be given at the 1st port at which a Survey to this Society may be present.

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation:
