Reverting to your letter of the 17th. May last respecting your Steamer "BAKUIN", I beg to acquaint you that I am now in receipt of a communication from Lloyd's Agents at Lima from which it appears that the Captain has arranged with the Agents to submit the vessel to Special Survey No. 3 at that port and I shall therefore feel obliged if you will kindly let me know whether this information is correct.

You will remember that in May last the Committee agreed to the Special Survey in question being postponed for a period of 12 months provided the vessel were thoroughly examined and a complete survey of the boilers carried out when the vessel dry docked at Callao within 6 months of that time.
