Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "BAKU STANDARD", I am directed to acquaint you that it appears from a report received from the Society's Surveyor at Philadelphia, that this vessel was examined afloat at that port as far as practicable, after having been aground.

Although no damage was discovered, it is recommended that the vessel should be placed in dry dock on her arrival at a home port, and I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly let me know when and at what port this will be done, and an opportunity afforded for one of the Society's Surveyors to make a complete inspection of the steamer's bottom.
