REPAIRS OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, *FOR* after collision, at Stated, with the Pierhead entering the Bassin Bellet at Havre on the 36th of August 1895.

Damage on port Side - Found the 1st and 2^d plates of the main keelstrake and five plates of Strakes below same more or less scored and indented; one plate of main St. Stringer twisted and fractured; the intercostal connections between panels, started; and, the beam ends, the panels, reversed panels and bracket fixed to tank top, in fore block, in way of this damage, more or less disturbed, twisted, and, in some cases, fractured. (See also Damage Survey left. attached.)

The rivetting and caulking of shell was found, generally, in sound condition, and the damage being well above the light water mark, it was decided, in order to avoid delays & consequent expenses, to take the vessel to Cardiff for re-examination & repairs. The Cardiff Surveyors have been advised accordingly.
