Nature of Survey

Damage

The Datoum Surveyor reports this vessel sustained damage through collision to bulwarks, 'tween deck plating and No. 5 tank. He states, however, that the damage does not affect the seaworthiness of the vessel, and as she is loading for the U.K. he recommends she should be docked on the first opportunity.

It is submitted the Owners be informed accordingly, and in the meantime the vessel's class might be allowed to remain undisturbed.
