I have to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a report from the Society's Surveyors at Genoa from which it appears that the barque "PAMIR" has been examined in drydock at that port. The Surveyors state that the vessel has been purchased by Messrs. Laeisz of Hamburg and that the Superintendent has assured them that on the vessel's arrival on the Continent she will be docked and surveyed for reclassification.

To entitle this vessel to have her class reinstated in the Society's Register Book a survey equal to a Special Survey No.3 must be held and in the circumstances I shall be glad if you will be guided accordingly should it be decided to submit the vessel to your inspection.
