Having, in accordance with your instructions, examined the Masts, Spars, and Rigging, and Iron Work of same, of the **Steel 4 Mast Bark "P A M I R" 3020 tons gross of Hamburg,** I have to report that I found the following:- Upper-main-topsail yard swivel bolt badly worn. Fore-lower-topsail yard has been removed to shop for repairs to riveting and plating. Wire binding of fore-top-gallant- backstay broken.-----
