Nature of Survey _____

The Rotterdam Surveyors now report that on account of damage through heavy weather, the port hawsepipe has been renewed, repairs effected to windlass, anchor crane and minor repairs carried out, and a bower anchor and 150 fathoms of chain cable of proper weight and test placed on board.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey.
