## REPORT ON MASTS, SPARS, AND RIGGING.

Having, in accordance with your instructions, examined the Masts, Spars, Iron Work of same, and Rigging, of the (of Vessel) 4-masted barque " P A M I R " of Mariehamn,

on the (Date of examination) 26 th day of August 1932,

I have to report that I found as follows: The main-topmaststay  
rigged down to be replaced by a new stay. The mizenuppergaff rigged  
down to be replaced by a new. The mizenboom rigged down for repair.

When inspecting the ship again on the 10th day of sept. I found that the work was done and that all rigging concerned was to be in very good condition.
