H. With reference to your letter of the 10th instant relative to the sailing vessel "PAMIR", I have to acquaint you I am now in receipt of a letter from the Owner intimating that he has decided to complete the Special Survey on completion of the vessel's discharge at your port, and stating that according to his records the rigging was surveyed at Mariehamn in August/ September last year.

In reply it has been pointed out to him that from the records in this Office it would appear that the rigging was examined at Mariehamn in August, but the lifting and stripping was not carried out as required by the Rules for the 2nd Special Survey No.3, and that if he still desires that a record of 2nd Special Survey No.3 should be assigned it will be necessary for this to be done.

I shall be glad if you will be guided accordingly.
