H. With reference to your report No. 8873 on the Bk. "PAMIR", I have to acquaint you that in October last the Society's Surveyors at Copenhagen reported that the 2nd Special Survey No.2 of this vessel had been advanced and that to complete the same the ceiling and steelwork in way of the ballast required to be examined.


The Owner subsequently asked that a notation of 2nd Special Survey No.3 might be assigned in lieu of the above survey, and he was advised that to entitle the vessel to such record the rigging requires to be lifted and stripped.

The Belfast Surveyors now report that the remaining requirements of the 2nd Special Survey No.2 have been complied with, and that they have been advised the rigging will be lifted and stripped on the vessel's arrival at Kotka in about three weeks' time.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will give the case attention.
