Nature of Survey

The Stockholm Surveyors report the ship examined afloat and the requirements of a S.S.No.3, due 5,36, partly complied with.

Ceiling in hold partly renewed and some minor repairs carried out.

It is stated that the Survey will be completed at Copenhagen in a few days.
