("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/32.)

Nature of Survey

A S.S.No.3, due 5,36, has been partly held at
Stockholm.

The Copenhagen Surveyors now report the Special Survey completed, but in reply to enquiry the Stockholm Surveyors write that the standing rigging requires to be lifted and the service and parcelling stripped off the nips, bends and splices for examination etc. (see letter dated 9.10.36).

It is submitted action be deferred pending the standing rigging being dealt with as required.

PLATING to be DRILLED when vessel is ~~30~~ years old, or at next Special Survey thereafter. (36)

The Stockholm Surveyors should be informed it is concluded they have taken up the matter of the rigging with the Owners with a view to the same being dealt with.
