Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter dated the 15th instant regarding the freeboards of the sailing vessel "PAMIR", and have duly noted your remarks.

The particulars given on the copy of the Rpt.C11 have been verified at the ship and found to be in order with the exception of certain measurements and particulars which are now given on the accompanying reports C.11(Comp.) and C.11(Contd.). In view of the nature of these particulars a revised freeboard assignment will be necessary.

A Load Line Renewal Survey on the vessel has been carried out and our Form C.11(d) will be forwarded in due course.

Particulars of the freeboards assigned by the Germanischer Lloyd and marked on the vessel are as follows:-

Summer Salt Water ..... 1720 mm.

Winter North Atlantic ..... 1795 mm.

Allowance for Fresh Water ..... 140 mm.

The freeboards are measured from the top of the wood deck.
