I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th instant forwarding a translation of a communication you have received from Captain Gustaf Erikson regarding the ships "LAWHILL", "OLIVEBANK", "PASSAT", "KILLORAN", "GRACE HARWAR", "VIKING", "PONAPE" and "PAMIR", from which I note that Convention freeboard certificates are desired for these vessels.

With regard thereto I have to inform you that before the certificates in question can be issued in respect of these ships it will be necessary for them to be surveyed in accordance with the requirements of the International Load Line Convention, and if you will be good enough to advise me as to when and at what ports the requisite surveys can be held, I shall have pleasure in instructing the Society's Surveyors concerned to give the cases the necessary attention.
