Dear Sir,

We have a letter from Captain Gustaf Erikson of Mariehamn, dated 15th instant, in which he writes translated as follows:-

"As there will soon be a question of new Loadline certificates according to International Loadline Conventions, one ought to get certificates from the different classification societies that the respective vessels fulfil the conditions of the Convention, and I am wondering if you could obtain these certificates for the vessels which are classed with Lloyd's. This applies to LAWHILL, OLIVEBANK, PASSAT, KILLORAN, GRACE HARWAR, VIKING, PONAPE and PAMIR. I am not, however, certain if the PASSAT and PAMIR have British Lloyd's freeboard certificate, when they both have belonged also to Germanischer Lloyd".

and we shall be grateful if you can let us have such certificates for Captain Gustaf Erikson.
