Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 9th instant relative to the four masted barque "PAMIR", and have placed the case before the Committee at their meeting today. The Committee have carefully noted your remarks in regard to the voyage proposed for this vessel, and I have the pleasure to say that in the circumstances they will not object to the 3rd Special survey No.1 being postponed to allow the vessel to proceed on the voyage New Zealand, Assumption Island, Auckland, should it not be possible to fix her on the contemplated voyage to Mauritius. It is noted that the vessel would then be drydocked at Auckland on completion of the proposed voyage.
