I am in receipt of your letter and enclosure of the 6th instant respecting the auxiliary motorship "PAMIR", the contents of which have been noted, and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that, provided the vessel is submitted to a satisfactory General Examination afloat, in accordance with Circular No.1959, on her return to the Continent in November, no objection will be taken to the Special Survey being postponed until November, 1956, as desired by the Owners, and I shall be glad if you will inform them and arrange accordingly.

I think it well to add that the Continuous Survey of the Oil Engines is considerably behindhand and to say that it is concluded that this inspection will be brought up to date at the General Examination.

At the same time I have to inform you that a reply is still awaited to the classing letter addressed to you on the 29th July.
