Dear Mr. Hunter,

We are in receipt of your letter of the 7th instant, referring to the large Cunard steamers.

With the three feet increase of breadth proposed it is thought that the beams should be 9" x 4" x 4" x 12/20" reduced to 10/20" ^{at ends} instead of 11/20" as shewn on the previous section.

We have had to make a few other amendments to accord with the plans previously agreed to.

When you have come to a final arrangement, I shall be glad if you will submit the plans decided upon for official approval.
