paragraph of your letter of the  
10th October last, I shall be  
glad to learn how these cases  
stand.

The present position is that the  
Owners of these vessels, in order  
to avoid bankruptcy proceedings,  
have applied for, and the Court has  
granted, a temporary stay of execution  
in respect of 45 creditors who have  
instituted distraint. A number of  
other creditors <sup>HAVE</sup> also sued or  
applied for distraint in respect of  
the Schliewen-Reederei.

The compromise aimed at would  
apply to 63 creditors who participate  
in an executable promissory note but  
have no further securities. Their  
claims amount to DM 675000.

It is known that Schliewen is  
endeavouring to sell the two vessels  
which are covered by mortgages of  
Landesbank Kiel. In Schliewen's opinion  
the money received for selling the  
vessels will be sufficient to satisfy  
the creditors.
