

Extract from Mr. Mudge's letter
dated 28th October, 1863..

Your letter, dated the 23rd Inst. was also
laid before the Rotation Committee, together
with the Report of Survey, N^o. 18415, on the
Iron Ship Ramsey, as extended and amended
by Mr. Pope, and which I return herewith, and
reverting to the remarks on this case, contained
in my letter of the 24th Inst., I have only
further to observe that as regards the Beams,
their actual spacing in this Ship is in accordance
with the Rules, and necessarily governed by the
actual spacing of the Frames, even though the
comparison taken by Mr. Pope be inadmissible.
