In October last the Owners stated this vessel was on the point of sailing for the Mediterranean, and they suggested she might be allowed to run until January before having the above surveys held. In the circumstances the Committee deferred consideration of the case for a time.

The vessel recently left London for Lisbon and Genoa without being submitted to survey, and in answer to enquiry the Owners state the overdue surveys will receive attention on her return to the United Kingdom from Genoa.
