I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 17th instant, with its enclosure, relative to the steamer "STETTIN", and note that the Owners intend to carry out the Screwshaft and Boiler Surveys of this vessel before she is again placed in commission. With regard to the 6th Special Survey No.2 I have to say that provided the major part of the survey be carried out before the steamer is recommissioned, and the vessel be examined by the Society's Surveyors and her general condition in other respects be found satisfactory, the Committee will be agreeable to the Special Survey being completed sometime within the year of grace allowed by the Rules, i.e. by the end of November, 1933.
