REPAIRS, &c. *now done* - Placed on blocks. Yellow metal sheathing cleaned and repaired (about fifty sheets renewed). Opposed caulked five seams down from Gunwale, also Stem chevrons and water ^{way} seams. Stitches in ceiling equal to a shackle on each side from After Hatch way to Fore Ripping, also the timbers on each side for the same distance, lifted & cleared for examination of cement which was found in good condition; Stuffing box to Rudder Head, and Steering Apparatus, cleared and refitted.
