The bottom has been sighted & the yellow metal sheathing where necessary. An extra plank beam (8" half with two angle irons 3"x3"x1/2") introduced forward and a plank stringer 19 1/2 ft. long, 1-1/2" wide & 7/8" thick the plank beams on each side of vessel forward, and attached to the reverse frames of iron 4 1/2"x4"x1/2". The bracket plates worked under this stringer plate at each frame. The vessel is in good and efficient condition & eligible in my opinion to remain as classed as now painted without having freeboard marks painted on her sides.
