Sir,

I have to acquaint you that the M<sup>r</sup>. "THERMOPYLAE", No. 324 in the Register Book, is now on a voyage from Victoria B.C. to your port, and that owing to her condition, it is considered that upon her arrival, she should be at once placed in dry dock, the metal stripped and her bottom thoroughly caulked, felted and re-stalled, when also the Special Survey required by the Rules to be held on composite vessels every 4 years, as set forth in paragraph 43, Rules 92 and 93 (Composite Rules) and which became due in December last, should be carried out, in order to entitle the vessel to retain her character in the Register Book.

I have therefore to request that you will give the case the necessary attention in due course.
