

Composite ship "Thermopylae"

With reference to the Officer's letter dated 17
Feb. 92, and to the special survey on this
vessel at Victoria B.C. it is submitted
the surveyor should be informed that the
special survey ^{has been} ~~is due~~ in December '91
and should be completed as soon as practicable.
The requirements of the rules ^{for composite ships} ~~are~~ set forth
in Sec. 43, paragraphs 3 and 4, should be
all complied with. And in view of the fact
that the metal was stripped off the bottom,
the bottom planking and fastenings examined,
and the vessel re-metalled at Rotterdam
May 1890, it will not be necessary to
remove the sheathing at this time if the
surveyor is satisfied with the condition
of the same and does not consider this
necessary. A report of the survey should
be written on a repair report form and in
the course forwarded for the information
of the Committee.
