Your letter of the 26th ultimo to hand
and contents noted.

In reply to your enquiry as to why
I did not send a report on Form N^o 12 of
the temporary repairs made to the S. S.
"Nederland" I would say that the repairs
made here were to the screw shaft and
propeller and consequently came under
the cognizance of the Engineer Surveyor,
Mr McDonald. I have also every reason
to believe that the Captain did not think
it necessary to avail himself of the services
of the Engineer Surveyor at this port seeing
that he intended to make permanent
repairs to the vessel at New York and
there have her Classification continued,
which will account for no survey being
held or report forwarded by the Engineer
Surveyor.

I enclose herewith, as directed,
Damage Report of Survey (S. 29), on S. S.
"Minia," of London E. B. This report would

have been forwarded to you at the time
the vessel arrived here from New York
had I not seen in supplement N^o 14
that the "Minia" had passed her N^o 1
survey in New York, in November last
and had her Classification continued
I inferred from that that a report from
me was neither required or desired,
see my letter of the 4th February. I
may add that I made no charge for
the services rendered by me as your
surveyor to the S. S. "Minia."
