

Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 15th inst. respecting the S.S. *Niederland* I beg to inform you that I have shown same to the Superintendent, who told me as follows:

The Company has the intention to renew the top of tank under boilers, but they intend to do this by degrees without laying the ship up, and to make a commencement on next arrival of the vessel at this Port; in January next she will be drydocked and the boilers on one side of the ship will be lifted, in June next she will be drydocked again and the other half of the boilers will be dealt with, so that the whole of the repairs will be completed about the middle of next year.
