 Upon visiting this vessel with respect to the completion of the S.S. No. 3, it was found that the two top covers referred to in the nautical list, had been previously renewed, and that upon the present occasion several of the defective plates of the tank top under the boilers have been renewed. The Superintendent state that arrangements were made with the Committee, whereby it was understood, that the tank top should be renewed in portions as the exigencies of discharging & unloading could admit, and it is expected that the work will be completed when the vessel returns. N.B. To complete the S.S. No. 3 the repairs to the tank top, under Boilers needs to be completed.
