SURVEY PARTLY HELD.

Particulars of Survey held, &c.

The 2nd S.S. No. 3 which became due 10.96 has been held at Antwerp in February and July 1897 and August 1898, with exception of the renewal of some tank top plates under the boilers.

The year of grace expired at the end of October last.

In August last the Committee approved of the Owners' proposal to renew the remainder of the plates in question, and test the tank on the vessel's next return to Antwerp.

The Antwerp Surveyors now write to say that the vessel arrived several days late from the last voyage, and as she had to keep her advertised sailing date, there was not time between her arrival and departure to admit of the completion of the 2nd S.S. No. 3 but the Owners' Superintendent informed them that arrangements are being made to complete the survey in question, when the steamer next returns to Antwerp.

It is submitted that this proposal merits the favourable consideration of the Committee, in view of the small portion of the survey remaining to be complied with, and in the meantime the vessel's class might be allowed to remain undisturbed.
