Nature of Survey

Completion of repairs.

This case was before the Committee on the 4th November last when the vessel was allowed to remain classed 100 A1 with record of survey 10,98 and notation of S.S. Ant. 2nd N°3-7,97 subject to the tankth under the boilers being riveted and the tank tested.

The Antwerp Surveyors now report that the riveting of the tank top under boilers has ~~now~~ been completed; the tank tested and found efficient.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain classed 100 A1 with record of survey 1,99 Ant and notation of S.S. Ant. 2nd N°3-7,97 without conditions.
