due for No. 3 Survey, is at present  
on a voyage from China to  
New York where we expect her  
to arrive about the middle of  
July. We intend having her  
checked & painted there, but  
as she is again going out to  
China from New York, before  
we bring her home here, when

we intend converting the  
engines & giving her new boilers,  
as well as a general overhaul,  
the present is to request that,  
under those circumstances,  
you will kindly allow the  
No. 3 survey to remain over till  
she comes home. The voyage  
should not exceed say about  
6 months.

We shall be very glad, at  
the same time, to give your  
Surveyors in New York every  
facility for making an  
examination of her while  
she is in dry dock, & also to  
make the annual survey of  
boilers & machinery.
