I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of yesterday date completing the Serial, January 13, of your Hon. Member's speech, & with reference thereto, I am anxious to acquaint you that under the circumstances of the case as set forth by you the Committee will allow the vessel's character to remain undisturbed in the Register Book provided the Survey be carried out, as proposed by you, on the vessel's return to the United Kingdom before the close of the present year & subject to her being examined on her arrival at New York should a being found in a satisfactory condition.
