Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "STRATHLEVEN", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a report from the Society's Surveyor at Shanghai of the Special Survey No.1 required by the Rules which has recently been completed on the vessel at that port.

It appears, however, that some damage sustained by grounding was only temporarily repaired to enable the vessel to proceed on her voyage, and action in regard to the case has therefore been deferred by the Committee until the necessary permanent repairs have been effected.

I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know in due course when and at what port the repairs in question will be carried out.
