In reply to the question asked in the Claising letter dated 20th November concerning the First Entry report on the M.V. "Gipsyholm", I have to inform you that the weather decks and waterways were all hose-tested, and flats in way of lavatories &c. were tested by flooding.

The capacity of Fresh water tanks at the sides of the tunnels is 860 tons (F.W.)

I would also add that the total length of "A" deck is 311'-8" and of "B" deck 344'-0".
