S I am in receipt of your letter of the 5th instant in reply to mine of the 3rd instant regarding the fees charged for the survey of the machinery of the Motorship "GRIPSHOLM", and note your explanation of the charges made by you in this instance.

In reply I have to say that if, as is concluded to be the case, Messrs. Burmeister & Wain, did not contract to carry out the work of installing the Machinery on board the vessel, the course adopted by you in charging 4/5ths of the total fees is in order, and the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle are being instructed accordingly.
