QUESTION

With reference to your memorandum dated the 4th February, I shall be glad to learn the position regarding the Screwshaft Survey, as so far this matter does not appear to have been dealt with as previously intimated.

ANSWER

Date:— 28th June, 1966 E680/66

We have been informed by the Owners that they intend to withdraw this ship from service appr. in October/Nov.66 with the view either to sell or to scrap her (this should be kept confidential for the time being). Therefore, the Owners kindly ask the Committee to postpone the survey of the starboard screwshaft as they do not want to drydock the ship before final decisions have been made.
