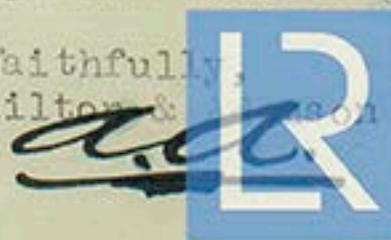
Dear Sirs, "Arandora Star".

as it is almost certain that proposals will be gone thro' with.


