With reference to the case of the S.S. "AQUITANIA"

I beg to inform you that application has been made to this Society for a revision of the freeboards assigned to this vessel, and it is found that a freeboard corresponding to an extreme draught of 36'-2" for all Seasons could be assigned; but before proceeding with the re-assignment it is desired to know if this draught would be approved by the Board of Trade under the regulations for sub-division of passenger steamers.
