Dear Mr. Lorkin,

S. I return herewith the rough draft of the transcript of my testimony in the case of the "BELPAMELA" and would congratulate you upon its clarity and its accuracy.

The only comments I have are as follows:-

Page 3, ninth line. I think should more correctly read as "not assigned that cross" rather than "that class".

Page 4, fifteenth line. I have deleted the "s" from "scantlings", which agrees with the description given in lines 8 and 10.

Page 6, fourteenth line. I think the word "still" ought to be omitted, or if you would prefer, altered to "stated". In the following line, too, you were correct in spelling "incidence" and not as corrected, so I have stated your original draft.

Page 11, second line. I would point out that S.S.No.1.45 merely indicates a Special Survey No. 1 held in 1945, and does not indicate January 1945. We do not put the month in our Special Survey records, except for a No.3 survey.

Page 12, towards the bottom. The word should be "occasional survey" and not "occasion survey", and in two lines below, I think I said "and reported" and not "or reported".

Page 16, second line. The words "you tell" refer actually to me, and I think should have correctly read "he tells".

I offer these comments for your consideration, and am quite content to leave any slight amendments in your capable hands.

I may add that I am preparing the certified photoprints of the reports referred to in the text and perhaps you would give me a telephone message on Monday morning as to whether I should send them to you by Mr. Kverndal.
