I enclose herewith a copy of a letter which has been received from the Sydney Surveyors, and with regard thereto shall be glad if you will endeavour to ascertain from the new Owners and let me know whether it is their intention to keep this vessel in class.

For your information, I think it well to add that, as a result of the satisfactory General Examination, the Committee have agreed to the Special Survey, which became due at the end of April last, being postponed until April next.

Although the Special Survey was commenced at Melbourne in January, 1956, and subsequently advanced, none of the parts then seen will be valid in April next, and, in this connection, I think it well to refer you to B. 803 of the Society's Rules.

The ship's class is subject to No. 2 keel plate from forward being examined and dealt with as necessary at the Special Survey.
