Dear Mr. Watt,

Many thanks for your letter of yesterday's date.

With regard to the case of Messrs. Alexander Stephen & Sons' No. 519, Mr. Munro informs me that his Report is held up in the meantime, pending receipt of certain particulars from the Board of Trade, but he will send this on to you officially as soon as possible.

I have, however, looked into the question of the scantlings and find that in accordance with our usual practice we used the Summer draft to determine the virtual depth. It, therefore, follows that seasonal lines should be applied.

I will, of course, give this information in the official reply when Mr. Munro's Report is sent up but thought it well to let you have this without delay.
