Dear Mr. Stupari,

I am favoured with your letter of the 17th instant in which you call attention to the working pressure of the main boilers which has been inserted on the First Entry certificate of the steamer "CONTE DI SAVOIA".

As it was apparent from the copy of the Secretary's letter of the 28th October last, which you were good enough to forward, that an error had been made, I have taken the matter up with the Chief Engineer Surveyor's Department who admit that by an unfortunate oversight the pressure was recommended to be recorded as 450 lb. per sq. inch, instead of the equivalent of 30 kgs. per sq. cm., viz:- 425 lb. per sq. inch.

I am very sorry that this error on the certificate should have occurred, and shall be glad if you will kindly return the machinery certificate for cancellation, and I will forward a fresh certificate with the correct pressure shown thereon.
