In conformity with the request contained in the classing letter dated 23rd December 1932 regarding the capacity of the double bottom tanks of the Q.S.S. "CONTE DI SAVOIA", I am enclosing herewith a sketch showing the general arrangement and capacity of all double bottom tanks and deep tanks, also their respective lengths.

It should be noted that, while the capacity of all compartments is shown in cubic metres on the sketch, the figures in our report correspond to tons of salt water.

A sketch showing the lengths of the upper bridge and promenade superstructures measured over the full extent of the shell plating is also enclosed.

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
