

Dear Mr. Sladden,

I duly received your letter of the 21st instant regarding the Emergency Oil Engine Electric Generator set No. 1999 (Genoa Report No. 12637), which was originally intended for the M.V. "OCEANIA". Same has been fitted on the Q. S.S. "CONTE DI SAVOIA" in place of engine No. 1971, (referred to in Genoa Report dated 14th June 1932), which was rejected owing to damages occurred during the working trials, and will in all probability be repaired and fitted on the "OCEANIA". The heading of Genoa Report No. 12637 should therefore be amended to "CONTE DI SAVOIA".
